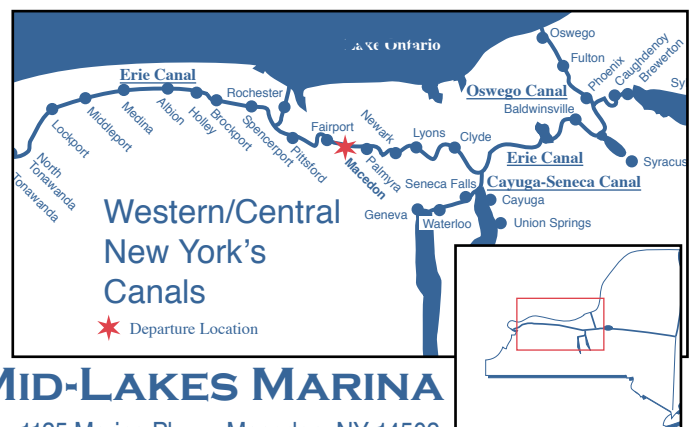

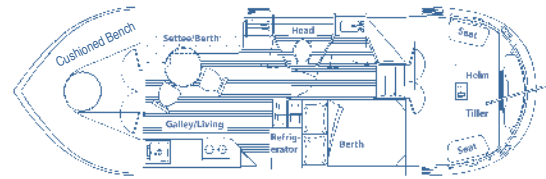

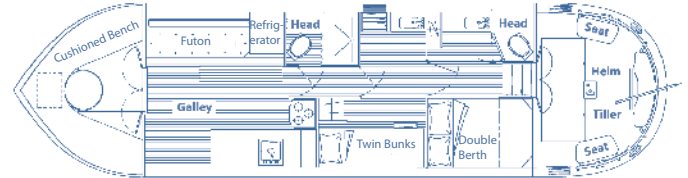
## LOCKMASTER LAYOUTS

### Lockmaster 33/34



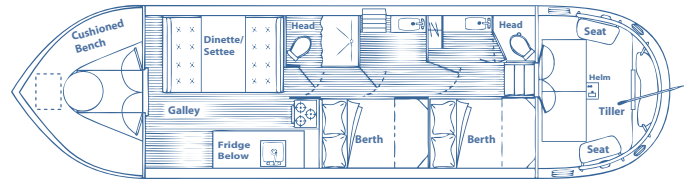
The *Canadice*, *Hemlock*, *Onondaga* and *Oneida* are perfect for a couple or young family. One private cabin with a double berth, one head and shower. Traditional pipe bunks (lower is twin size, upper is smaller) in the galley/living area and cushioned benches in the canvas-enclosed bow.

### Lockmaster 41



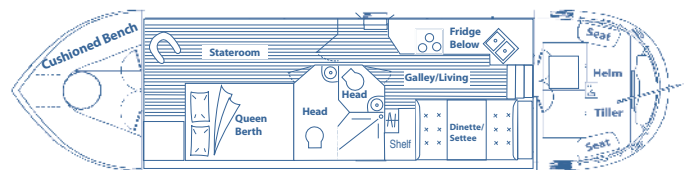
The *Skaneateles II* and *Cayuga*. One double-berth cabin and one cabin with bunk beds. Additional sleeping in the living area. Two heads and a shower. Canvas-enclosed bow area with cushioned benches.

The *Seneca*, *Canandaigua*, *Okeechobee* and *Otisco II*. Two double-berth cabins. Additional sleeping in the living area. Galley, two heads, one shower and canvas-enclosed bow area with cushioned benches.
